

International Travel Health & Safety Forum

Purpose:

Collectively aim to improve the support provided to Cornell's international travelers as it relates to health, safety, and security.

Mission:

The International Travel Health & Safety (ITHS) Forum will:

1. Bring together representatives from stakeholder units across campus who both work directly with travelers prior to departure, and as response personnel during and after incidents affecting travelers while abroad.
2. Provide recommendations on guidelines, protocols, techniques, tools, events, and policy that mitigates foreseeable risk, better prepares international travelers, and promotes effective response and recovery.
3. Be responsible for staying apprised of, and disseminating information regarding protocols, procedures, policy, and best practices to their respective units.

Composition:

The Forum will strive for representation from, but not limited to, the following:

Reporting:

The Associate Director of International Travel Health & Safety will serve as Director of the Forum. As a member of the International Travel Advisory and Response Team (ITART) they will bring issues, reports, and advocacy for the Forum's recommendations to ITART and other relevant stakeholders.

Meetings:

Meetings will be held quarterly or as needed.
